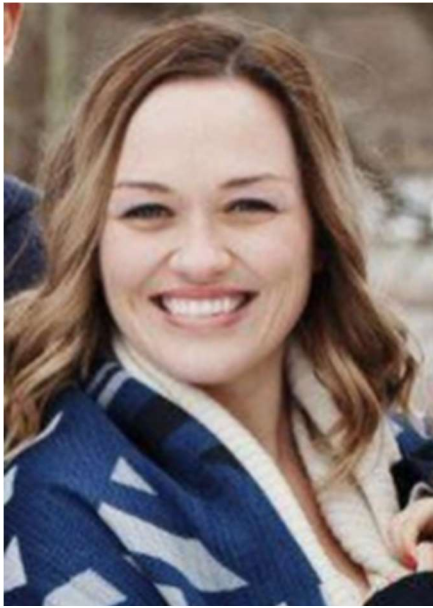


MIDWIFE OF THE MONTH
